Writing Hint

Taste is unique to each one of us, and as such can be hard to get across in our writing.
Try using taste words as adjectives:

"the salty sweat dripped down her face"
"the acidic aftertaste of his morning coffee, still
lingered at the back of his throat"

using a simile when explaining taste often helps the reader experience this sense.

"The undercooked bacon felt like a wet, yet greasy sponge placed on my tongue."
